Nancy was a longtime member of the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship Church of Midland, where she gave of her time and talent in their kitchen helping with hospitality and as an accomplished piano and organ player. She also made time to enjoy many hobbies, including gardening, swimming, golf, tennis, traveling, and playing bridge and euchre.

Nancy is survived by her children, Barbara Keene, Karen Keene Wilder, Angela (Kevin) Trepanier, and Joseph Tutera; grandchildren, Christal Schoen, Melissa Schoen, Lindsey (Mike) Mortier, Alexandra Trepanier, and Amber Trepanier; five great-grandchildren; two cousins, MaryLou (Ernie) Nagy and Marti (Ron) DeLong. She was preceded in death by her daughter, Molly Erin Keene Schoen, her parents, and her stepfather, Albert Nitz.
